
# Minaader




# Nibwaaak ~WiSd~

need to use them (Our 7 Ojibway Teachings; 2014).




Elders are full of wisdom. All their experiences are like fruits in a basket that is shared.






# Daabadendzi

# Debowen Truth




The turtle represents truth. Truth is spoken from the heart. The turtle carries all the teachings on its back
